I greet you on the occasion of the greatest Christian Feast. However, before I extend to you my Easter wishes, I would like to share with you something very personal. There are two recollections from my childhood.

My grandmother kept telling me very often: Only when you loose something, you will understand how important and valuable it was.

The second recollection is concerned with World War II. One of my cousins told me that her grandfather after coming back home from the war, attended two Holy Masses every Sunday. When asked by his daughter: Father, why are you doing it?, she heard him say: while in captivity I could not attend Holy Masses for over three years. Now I can and I wish to make it up to God.

I think a few of you feel uncomfortable that you cannot go to church to participate in the liturgy and take the Eucharist. Just now, with all restrictions and directions to stay home, life looks different from what it was before. We tend to understand how many things, gifts and persons we have not seen or we have seen but insufficiently...

I wish, therefore, to wish You that Easter time fills you with the belief that God is always with us!

Be sure that the Resurrected Christ who won death, sin and Satan will help us overcome the pandemic crisis.

I wish you such a longing for Jesus, for the Sacraments, and for singing that when all this is over - you will be able even more zealously and strongly than now serve God and Church in order to love better!

I wish you hope which has its source in the risen Lord who will never let us down!
