Try to be the apostles of Jesus. Use your words and set a good example of His love to your friends and the people you meet every day.

I am also asking you for prayer, which our big Pueri Cantores family needs as much as the whole world. Wherever children and young people pray, our God gives His favour and blessing with joy.
