## **Online Taizé Prayer**

### FLOW of the Prayer Conducted on Zoom (using Apple Keynote) Total duration: approx. 35 min

- 1. Introduction These are **Instructions** for participation on screen, and an in invitation to **type intercessory requests** in the chat box before the start of the actual prayer.
- 2. Welcome (live) optional.
- 3. A Bell rung to indicate the start of prayer (live)
- 4. Chant to Holy Spirit (pre-recorded)
- 5. Chants and Psalms of Taizé (pre-recorded)
- 6. Invitation to participants to make a very brief prayer of **Thanksgiving** (live, spontaneous)
- 7. Short **Scripture** Reading *(live)*
- 8. Silent Reflection (aided by 2 or 3 slides, approx. 5 -7 min in all)
- 9. Intercessions (spoken live) with chant response (pre-recorded) and accompanied by slides displaying the intercessions that were sent in the chat at the start.
- 10. The Lord's Prayer and a **Closing Prayer** (live)
- 11. Closing Chant/s (pre-recorded
- 12. A Bell rung to indicate the end of prayer (live)

Features: Easy to do; Use of simple chants pre-recorded by a choir; Takes around 2 to 3 weeks preparation to organize.

#### **Preparation work**

- A group of young people come together to choose a **theme.** (can be a choir or a youth group led by a choir director or group leader)
- Based on **personal sharing** about day to day situations at the local and global level a theme emerges.
- A sentence or phrase from Scripture can be proposed by each and shared, to bring out the theme. The most suitable is identified.
- Deeper Sharing and reflection on the scripture line follows over the next few days, based on which the **Reflection** presentation is drawn up using words, questions, or simple illustrated graphics. The key aspect is simplicity. The final reading of scripture may include a few lines before and after the key scripture line.
- Intercessions are prepared by another group of participants. Appropriate chants are chosen by choir leader.
- The Flow of the Prayer is put into a **Keynote/PowerPoint** presentation. Reviewed.
- Time best suited for all to participate is fixed.
- A Zoom Link is created. The LINK is shared with all including friends and relatives and parishioners.

#### Production/Execution/Technical

- Select the Taizé chants you would like to use from the wide selection available.
- When choirs are not meeting in person, each singer may record his/her parts on their mobile phones. The accompanying track is sent to them.
- Compile the recordings to produce the final choir performance.
- Each group can find their own way of recording and producing the choir chants.
- Put all the pre-recorded parts into Keynote/PowerPoint according to the flow, taking care to leave one blank slide for anything live.
- During the prayer, sort the intercessions received on the Zoom chat into categories and inserting them into the Keynote slides.

**P.S.** We propose creating a bank of chants recorded by various choirs that can be made available for use by anyone.
